<b>Oct 7 - Al Larrabee:</b> four vaux swift--late?
<b>Oct 8 - Lyn Topinka:</b> Lewis Woodpecker, juvenile, seen on Carty Unit, on snags on lake north of Carty Lake, and on snags directly across Duck Lake as seen from the Plankhouse
<b>Oct 8 - Jim Danzenbaker:</b> Stunning Great-horned Owl show on Kiwa Trail on evening BirdFest tour including two hooting side by side on exposed branch - video!
<b>Oct 9 - Randy Hill:</b> Most species from observation blind during "Big Sit" 7am-6pm. Pacific-Slope Flycatcher was along trail to blind. Bald Eagle also seen by group.
<b>Oct 11 - Alex Chmielewski:</b> Brant on Rest Lake mixed in with a flock of cacklers
<b>Oct 11 - Jim Danzenbaker:</b> 6pm on Tuesday - 200+ Long-billed Dowitchers, 34 Greater Yellowlegs, 1 Dunlin and 1 basic plumaged Black-bellied Plover on rest Lake
<b>Oct 11 - Randy Hill:</b> Alex found Brant at south end of Rest Lake.
<b>Oct 12 - Alex Chmielewski:</b> approx 1200 widgeon on Carty Lake in the late afternoon
<b>Oct 12 - Roger Windemuth:</b> Horned Grebe today in S. Big Lake on far side.
