#### Refuge Open Hours: 8:00 am - 4:30 pm\*

\*Note- Open hours change rapidly this time of year, make sure to check <u>the USFWS website</u> before heading out.

#### Daily Entrance Fee:

- \$3.00 daily per vehicle, or up to four adults on foot.
- \$15.00 for an Annual Ridgefield National Wildlife Refuge pass.

Payment by cash or check only. You can find payment envelopes at the kiosk in each unit.

### The following federal lands passes are valid and must be registered at an entrance kiosk.

Note - State Discover passes are not valid at National Wildlife Refuges.

- America the Beautiful Annual Pass
- Senior Pass (Annual or Lifetime)
- Access Pass for those with a permanent disability
- Active Duty Military and Dependent passes
- Veteran's and Gold Star Families passes
- Every Kid Outdoors 4th Grade Grade Pass
- Volunteer Pass (earned with 250 hours of service)
