- Ridgefield NWR comprises approximately 5,300 acres of marshes, grasslands and woodlands
- The public can visit two units of Ridgefield NWR, the Carty Unit, and the River 'S' Unit Auto Tour Route
- Management emphasis at RNWR is on providing habitat for wintering waterfowl, particularly the Dusky Canada Goose
- Over 200 bird species have been observed at RNWR
- RNWR is one of over 560 refuges nationwide
- RNWR is one of only two roosting areas in Washington State for sandhill cranes.
- The Friends of RNWR, in conjunction with Refuge staff and the City of Ridgefield, host BirdFest & Bluegrass the first weekend in October; a family-friendly event with many activities suitable for all ages!
